AT&T ADDRESS BOOK

Activate AT&T Address Book

1. From the idle screen, select **Menu** and then **AddressBook (8)**.
2. Select **OK** and then **Accept** to sign up.
3. Select **Yes** to synchronize this phone with the contacts in the online Address Book.
4. Once contacts are imported, select **Merge** to combine phone and online contacts together or **Replace** to replace contacts on the phone with those online.
5. Now the Address Book is ready to use and will continue to sync as needed.

TEXT MESSAGING

Send a Message

1. From the idle screen, select **Menu**, then **Messaging (2)**, and then **Create message (1)**.
2. Press the **OK Key** to access your Address Book. Scroll to the desired contact and press the **OK Key** for **Select** and then the **Left Soft Key** for **Done**.
3. Press down on the **Navigation Key** to access the text entry box. Start composing your message.
4. When you are done typing, press the **OK Key** to send the message.

Reading Text Messages

1. From the idle screen, select **Menu**, then **Messaging (2)**, and then **Inbox (2)**.
2. Press the **OK Key** for **Select** to open the highlighted message.

Please don't text and drive.

MOBILE EMAIL*

1. From the idle screen, select **Menu**, then **Email & IM (3)**, and then **Mobile Email (1)**.
2. Select an email provider from the list. Select **Sign Up** to sign up for the Mobile Email service. The steps that follow may vary depending on your provider; follow the on-screen instructions. You may be asked to agree to terms of use.
3. Enter your email address and password, and then press the **OK Key** for **Sign In**.
4. Scroll to the email message you want to read and press the **OK Key** to download its content.
5. Press the **Left Soft Key** to delete, reply to, or forward.

*Mobile email requires a subscription to a monthly service plan.

TAKE AND SEND PICTURES

Take a Picture

1. From the idle screen, press the **Camera Key** on the right side of the phone.
2. Line up your shot and press the **Camera Key** again to take the picture.
3. Press the **OK Key** to save the photo.

Send a Picture

1. After taking a picture, press the **Left Soft Key** for **Options**.
2. Select **Send (1)** and then **Via Message**.
3. Press the **OK Key** to choose a contact from your address book.
4. Scroll down to the text entry box and compose your message.
5. When you are done typing, press the **OK Key** for **Send**.

Note: Photos will automatically be saved in **My Stuff > Pictures > My pictures**. To record video, select **Switch to video camera** from the **Options** menu in the camera. Videos will automatically be saved in **My Stuff > Video > My Videos**.

AT&T MOBILE SHARE

To Open Your Online Locker

1. From the idle screen, select **Menu** and then **Online Locker (0)**.
2. Read the terms and conditions and then select **Accept** by pressing the **OK Key**.

After Taking a Photo

1. Once you have taken a picture, select **Options** and then **Send (1)**.
2. Select **Via Mobile Share**.
3. Choose your upload destination or select **Add Sites & People** to add additional people or social networks to your destinations list.
4. Select **Send**.

AT&T SOCIAL NET

1. From the idle screen, select **Menu** and then **Social Net (9)**.
2. To accept data charges if asked, select **Continue**. To accept the End User License Agreement, select **Accept**.
3. Select the social network of your choice from the top row.
4. Enter your login and password. Select **Sign in**. You now have access to your social network.

Access Social Networks and Information

- Select , , or to quickly update your status.
- Select for the latest news and information.
- Select for a snapshot of all of your status updates.

AT&T MUSIC

1. From the idle screen, select **Menu** and then **AT&T Music (7)**.
2. Accept the terms of service, and then read the warning and select **Continue**.
3. Once you have accessed AT&T Music, you can:
 - 🎵 Listen to your music collection with an enhanced music player for your phone.
 - 🎵 Access your music collection by song, artist, album, genre, or playlist.
 - 🎵 Listen to 40+ commercial-free Genre Radio stations.
 - 🎵 Get your radio, your way with unlimited personal radio stations.
 - 🎵 Name that song with Song Match.
 - 🎵 Get unlimited lyrics lookup with Lyric Match.
 - 🎵 Buy songs and albums from your favorite artists and download them right to your phone!

MULTITASKING*

1. If you're involved in one task and want to launch or switch to another, press the **Key**. You can then select an open task, **Home**, or **Menu**.
2. To end a task, press the **Key**, scroll to the task you wish to close, and press the **Left Soft Key** for **Options**. Select **Close (1)** to close that task or **Close all (2)** to close all open tasks.

*Music and voice applications cannot be used at the same time.



INSTANT MESSAGING

To Choose Your IM Service

1. From the idle screen, select **Menu**, then **Email & IM (3)**, and then **IM (2)**.
2. Select an instant messaging service. The steps that follow will vary depending on your service.
3. Enter your screen name and then press down on the **Navigation Key** to move to the **Password field** and enter your password.
4. Highlight **Sign In** and press the **OK Key**.

To Use IM

1. Once signed in, you're ready to send instant messages to your buddy list already set up with your IM service.
2. To exit IM, select **Options, Exit (8)**, and then **Sign Out (2)**.

APPCENTERSM

Access AppCenter

1. From the idle screen, select **Menu** and then **AppCenter (5)**.
2. Browse categories to view content and applications available for download.

Access Downloaded Games and Applications on Your Phone

1. Once you have downloaded a game or application, from the idle screen, select **Menu**, then **My Stuff (*)**, and then **Games & Apps**.
2. Select either **Applications** or **Games**.
3. Scroll to the game or application and press the **OK Key** to open it.

USING BLUETOOTH[®]

Pairing

1. Before you begin, place your *Bluetooth* device into pairing mode.* From the idle screen, select **Menu**, then **Settings (#)**, **Connections (4)**, and **Bluetooth (1)**.
2. Select **Search for new device (5)**. If prompted, turn on *Bluetooth* by selecting **Yes**.
3. Select the name of the device you wish to pair with and press the **OK Key**.
4. If prompted for a passkey,* enter the passkey and press the **Left Soft Key** for **Pair**.

Connecting

To connect to the device, select **My devices (3)**, scroll to the device name, and press the **OK Key** for **Connect**.

*Please consult the documentation included with the *Bluetooth* device for information on placing the device into pairing mode and entering the passkey (typically 0 0 0 0 – four zeroes).

MOBILE VIDEO

1. From the idle screen, select **Shortcuts**.
2. Choose **Mobile Video (6)**.
3. Once connected, use the **Navigation Key** to scroll up/down and the **OK Key** to select the video category and clip you wish to view.

Personalize Your Mobile Video Content

1. From the Mobile Video home page, scroll to the bottom and select **Customize Mobile Video**.
2. Select **Edit My Favorites**.
3. Highlight the content you would like to appear on your Mobile Video home page and press the **OK Key** to select it.
4. Select **Home** to save your settings and return to the Mobile Video home page.

AT&T NAVIGATORSM

To Start AT&T Navigator

1. From the idle screen, select **Menu**, then **AT&T GPS (1)**, and then **AT&T Navigator (2)**.
2. Press the **Left Soft Key** for **Yes** to agree to the terms of service.
3. Press the **Left Soft Key** to log in.
4. Read the warning and press the **Left Soft Key** for **Agree**. You may then choose to view a tour of AT&T Navigator features.

Navigator Options

- **Drive To** – get directions to a destination.
- **Search** – find a location or business.
- **Maps & Traffic** – get the latest local traffic and map information.
- **Tools & Extras** – learn more about AT&T Navigator and set your preferences.
